NATIONAL PRESCRIPTION TAKE-BACK DAY IS APRIL 28

WHO: Participating Price Chopper stores, in cooperation with local law enforcement and the U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration.

WHAT: National Prescription Take-Back Day – Kansas Citizens are encouraged to go through their medicine cabinets, remove any unused or expired prescriptions, and bring them to a participating Price Chopper grocery store for safe, anonymous and free disposal.

WHEN: Saturday, April 28, 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.

WHERE: Select Price Chopper stores. Participation may vary by location; see list below.

WHY: Medicines in the home are a leading cause of accidental poisoning and contribute to the growing opioid abuse problem, as most prescription drug abusers report getting their drugs from friends and family.

- According to the 2015 National Survey on Drug Use and Health, 6.4 million Americans abused controlled prescription drugs.
- Data from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention show that as of 2015, an average of 91 Americans die every day from an opioid overdose.
- Further, four out of five new heroin users started with prescription medications, according to the Drug Enforcement Administration.
- Since the inaugural Drug Take-Back Day in September 2010, more than 9 million pounds of prescription drugs have been gathered and safely disposed of.
